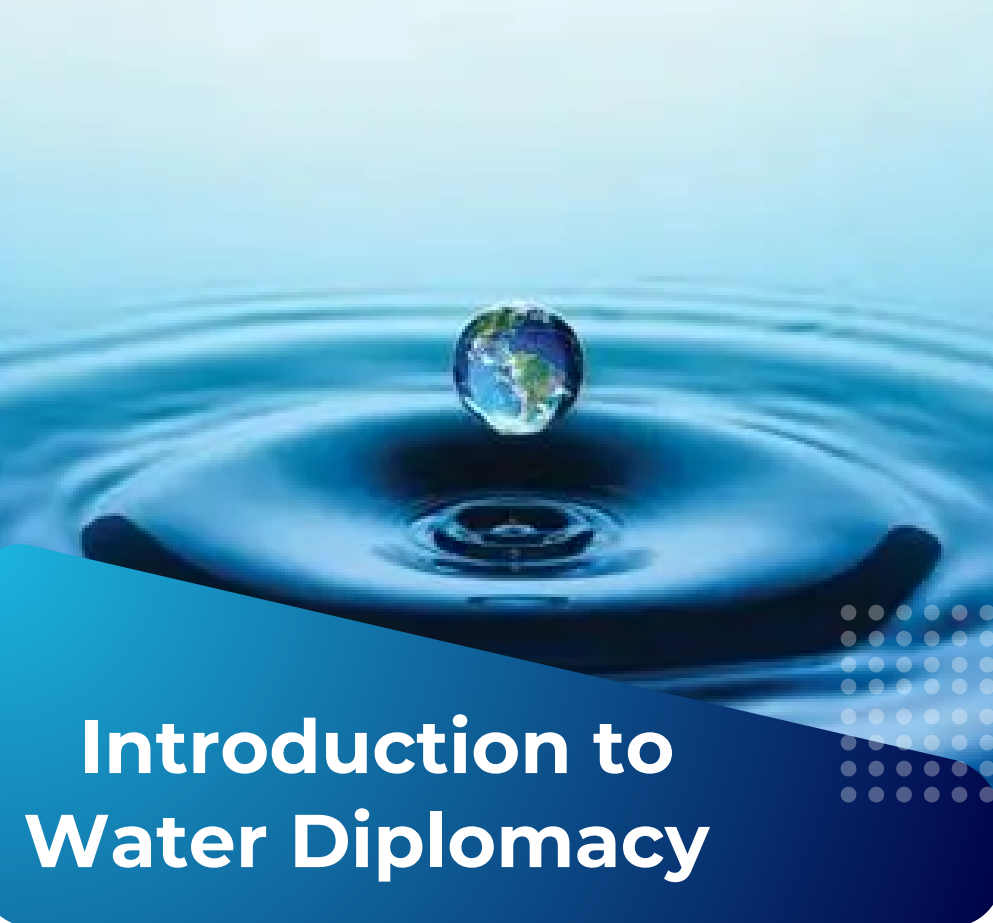




Introduction to Water Diplomacy
